Who?

Forest Kids is a new project in Ash and the surrounding area, providing opportunities for children and young people to have fun and learn new skills in a woodland setting. We are a registered charity and have a safeguarding policy, including DBS checking team members.

What?

We run regular sessions at our woodland site where children can take part in a range of activities that will help them grow in confidence, have fun, learn about the natural world and bushcraft skills, all at the same time as learning about how the life of Jesus can help us live life well today.

Sessions are for primary school aged children (5-11) and are free. Parents are welcome to come to the sessions, especially the first time.

When?

Currently fortnightly on a Saturday mornings, 10.30am-12.00pm.

The woodland site we use for Forest Kids sessions is in Normandy but we are providing a minibus pick up service from Ash and Ash Vale.
